

The first thing that strikes me right off the bat is the stellium of planets you have in the sign of Virgo. Your Sun, Jupiter, Mercury, Venus, Moon, Pluto and Uranus all reside within this sign. There is a heavy emphasis on the conjunction shared between your Venus, Moon and Pluto. These three are the closest of the bunch, Venus being at 20° 51', Moon being at 20°51' and Pluto being at 21°54′ the three of them exist within a degree's length apart from one another,



they're practically one entity! These three are themes in your life, they are the big hitters that intend to guide you and teach you through your life.

In Virgo, the sign of the apprentice - duty and integration, we are graced by the kisses of Venus and of the sweet mother Moon, and of... wait just here, who invited Pluto to the party? The short answer to that question is - Your Soul did. Yes, your higher self invited Pluto, the lord of the underworld, to this Virgo party, and it is up to you to learn how to handle this potent Plutonic energy throughout your lifetime.

As much as Pluto can be seen as a destroyer, he can indirectly be seen as a way paver for new life. We can easily recognize the potential of life in death with the examples of compost or manure. Death is a part of life, and it is up to us to understand the depths of it and to apply it accordingly within the realm of the living. The

presence of Pluto here in your natal chart reveals that there is something for you in the underworld that you are to become intune with, and it is for you to transmute the underworld into a higher octave that encourages regeneration as opposed to stagnation.

If we look at the mythology of Osiris - we see an arityphe of Pluto that is less known. Osiris was once the living king of Lower Egypt, until he was murdered and dismembered by his brother Set. This event devastated Osiris' counterpart and wife, Isis - who went to the edges of the Earth to locate every piece of Osiris and to reassemble him back into form. Once reassembled, Osiris came back, but not to the land of living - he came back to the realm of the spirit, and became a being bound to the land of the dead. Osiris is made king of this land. Once King of the dead, Orisis was depicted in art as having green skin, a reflection of the regenerative qualities of death.

Furthermore Osiris' underworld differed from the western Greek God Hades' underworld. First off, Osiris' underworld was really more of a land for the dead to continue living in spiritual form. Whereas Hades' underworld was more like a prison for shadows and beaten down souls. No one could return from Hades' underworld without some sort of high price to be paid.

An example of a high price is shown in the myth of Persophone and Ceres. In this myth Persophone, a beautiful young maiden and daughter of Ceres, is out picking narcissus flowers - when suddenly the Earth cracked open. From this crack jumps out four black horses pulling a dark cloaked man in a chariot. The man in the chariot grabs Personhpone and then dips back in the cracked Earth - leaving no trace of Persophone or of her abduction.

The sun sets on the day, and Persephone is nowhere to be seen. Ceres grows worried when her daughter Persphone never returns home. She panics and rips off her goddess garbs, taking on the appearance of a mortal. She then hits the streets in search of her daughter.

Ceres, being the goddess of agriculture and nutrition, essentially gives up her divine duties while on the hunt for her daughter. And it is during this time that the Earth begins to turn cold and weather hostile. Crops can no longer take in the soil and hunger begins to creep into the lives of humans.

Zeus in Olympus sees that the mortals are suffering greatly, and instigates a meeting between Ceres and Hades - begging them to make a

compromise, something that would motivate Ceres to keep up with her godly role of nurturer and ultimately keep the mortals fed.

A compromise was made between Ceres and Hades, it being that for nine months out of the year Persphone would live above ground and for the remaining 3 months of the year, she would live below ground with Hades. This myth is where the four seasons stem from and it is also in this myth where the symbolism of surrender is born. The female mysteries were surrendered when Persephone took citizenship in the underworld - making room for the patriarchy to take full form.

We can look at Ceres as Isis in the myth of Ceres & Persephone and we can look at Persophone as Osiris in this myth as well. When we do this, we suddenly see the masculine principle being sent to the underworld, and we see the feminine principle navigating and channeling between the land of the living and the land of the dead.

Western society has sculpted Osiris (Pluto) into a brute and selfish force. Whereas in Egyptian culture, Osiris was seen as an integral watcher of the dead. And a being who assisted the feminine and her regenerative nature. Hades captures and controls curious, innocent and creative feminine nature, where Osiris complements it. Death implies life and life implies death.

With you, we are here to balance these poles of life and death and you are here to embrace extreme change. This is emphasized with the tight conjunction of your Moon to Pluto. The moon being the quickest body in astrology, orbiting around the Earth and changing signs about every 2 to 3 days, your emotional body is like a barometer - picking up subtle pressure changes and subtle bodies as they enter a room.

To comment on your Venus, Isis is linked to the planet Venus and the fact that your natal Venus, Moon and Pluto are so close to one another, emphasizes the Isis and Osiris archetypes in you as well. You are a very sensitive being, and the archetype of Osiris and Isis are strong within you, both in their triumphs and their traumas.

Set is the brother of Osiris, and he is also his murderer. Not too far from your Pluto placement, about 6° away is your Uranus and about 16° from your Uranus is your South Node in Libra. Now, 16° is a wide orb, and usually not worth discussing, however in your case, these placements all reside with your 2nd house, of creature comforts, desires, sensuality and money.

These placements suggest turbulence within the things that bring you comfort and random acts of betrayal from those that you love. These placements may lead you to feel as someone who is searching for their place in a world that they cannot trust.

On the other side of your second house is the 8th house, where your North Node and Chiron reside. The 8th house carries the energy of Pluto, or on a lighter note Osiris. The North Node represents our soul's destiny, and it is also a point that represents our future nature as opposed to our past nature - a nature that is typically bogged down with trauma and bad habits. Living in our South Node feels comfortable to us, whereas living in our North Node feels uncomfortable to us, at least while we are getting the hang of it.

Your North Node residing in your 8th house, reveals that you are being challenged to heal the wounds of betrayal and to break down your own guarded walls of protection. Are you willing to forgive and are you willing to share, deeply, all that you have learned from experiencing the shadows of life? Are you willing to become a channel between the light and the dark?


Being such a strong Virgo individual, I can imagine that you run a tight ship and often hide within your own routine to avoid individuals and situations. Your Leo rising, helps convince others that you have it all figured out with a smile on your face - but if you ignore the depths of your being - the Osiris, you find yourself exploding when you have reached your limits of the facade. It catches yourself and others off guard, and likely alienates you from getting down to the root of your own emotions.

We can look to the wisdom of Chiron the wounded healer in these moments of explosion. Chiron, being a beloved teacher in the Greek pantheon, was wounded by one of his own students - by bow and arrow to the groin during a day of hunting practice. The arrow that was cast was dipped in the magickal blood of Medusa and could not be healed. Being immortal, Chiron would surfer from this wound for his entire existence. He learned from his pain, forgave his student and became a medicine man who would go on to teach and heal many.

With all this being said, there is a magic to your wounds and it is for you to share that alchemy with others. This may be the role of your daughter in your life. An individual that is born with a unique disposition to life and someone who is very close to you. You cannot hide behind your walls with her, you are being asked to navigate both the upper and lower worlds for and with her.

Your daughter and you share a Jupiter South Node Conjunction, your South Node is conjunct to Mia's Jupiter by 2°33′. This means that CHILD's Jupier opposes your North Node and implies that CHILD is an evolutionary trigger for you in this life. Jupiter expands whatever it touches, and in your case CHILD is both expanding your past life karma as well as expanding your potential to grow into your soul's destiny.

You two have likely interacted in past lives together. Taking on different roles outside of mother and daughter. In this case CHILD appears to have been some sort of authority over you, perhaps a provider of wealth and security. With her Jupier opposing your 8th house and your North Node, it suggests that you will be the one sharing wealth with her - in fact it is your duty to evolve through this process of sharing your wealth, in all of its forms, with her, be it material and immaterial.



Close to your South Node is the asteroid Pallas Athena, she is a goddess that represents creative wisdom and intelligence as well as a fear for success. It is possible that in a past life you were very talented, creatively and intellectually although you were never validated for your work and this discouraged your spirit. Your daughter may have even been in the role of the being that limited you,

even though she supported your physical and financial welfare.

We can also say it like this - in a past life you devoted yourself to a career that allowed you to live materially well, but on the inside your creative spirit was being ignored and suffering. Your daughter may have been your boss, or perhaps an out of reach company shareholder, someone distant but very much a part of the system that was choking your creative spirit.

I ask you to tune into yourself, for the specifics behind the characters and the scenarios of your past lives, I am only offering archetypes with the intention of sparking your imagination to remember what is true. What is important here is the energy and the rhythm created by these past life energies and scenarios - because these are things that are being repeated for you in this lifetime.

CHILD's natal North Node 29°49' Aries is conjunct with your natal Saturn 25°15' Aries. You are teaching her creativity in this lifetime – guiding her to create her own way, see the bigger picture and too invite more Venustion love into her life. As you spiritually evolve, soften, forgive and invite more unconditional love into your life – the more this will affect Mia and teach her. You are parenting someone who is here to see things differently. You are her guide to help her master and develop her perspective.

Your MC in Equal House lands in the 9th House, reflecting that your true calling has something to do with natural truths and beliefs, spiritual - ethical and beyond. Your MC is at 14°36′ Taurus and Mia's Venus and Mars are sitting over there in Scorpio opposing your MC by less than a degree each. Your daughter in this lifetime has something to do with enhancing your career and overall public image.

I feel that the synastry shared between you and your daughter reflects an evolutionary relationship, where she will help you evolve just as much as you evolve her. Your career likey shifted after Mia's birth and it is this shift that has catalyzed the search for a more fulfilling career.

There is something in you that is calling for a more etheric and spiritual life. It is your destiny to learn how to integrate the extreme changes you have experienced in this life and to teach others them - starting with your daughter. You are here in part to teach others how to overcome and not carry the baggage of the underworld on their shoulders.
